### 18 OR UNDER?

A drop-in service for young people is available at Chalmers Centre, Edinburgh, EH3 9ES. They are open Monday to Thursday from 3:30pm to 7pm and Friday from 1pm – 3:30pm.

There are no appointments, just turn up during the drop-in times. One of the specially trained youth workers will welcome you and can tell you what to expect.

#### WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?

You will need to provide some information on your physiology, so that the most appropriate test can be ordered. You will also need to provide a Lothian address for the kit to be sent to. This does not have to be your home address.

The test will arrive with full instructions for you to carry out in a safe and private place.

You will be given a phone number to call to receive your results. Your results will be ready within 7-14 days.

#### **TESTING WINDOWS**

The testing window is the amount of time that needs to pass after exposure to an STI before it will be picked up by a test.

- Chlamydia: 10 days after exposure
- Gonorrhoea: 10 days after exposure
- Syphilis: 6 weeks after exposure and retest after 3 months
- Hepatitis B: 4/6 weeks after exposure
- Hepatitis C: 3 weeks after exposure
- HIV Anti Body Test (Rapid Test): 3 months after exposure
- HIV Blood Test: 4 weeks after exposure
- Herpes: 6-12 weeks after exposure
- HPV (Human Papillomavirus): 4 months after exposure
