

Test before you ingest

The product you buy might not always be the drug you expect. Drugs in circulation may be more potent than expected meaning you need less of them to feel the effects. They might be a mix of unexpected contents and be more risky.

A drug testing kit is something anyone can use. It involves using chemical 'reagents' that change colour depending on which drug they are exposed to. They do not give as much information as lab analysis would. The effectiveness of test kits depends on you following all instructions properly, and also reading the results properly.

Test kits can rule IN the presence of a drug but cannot accurately rule OUT the presence of all possible adulterants (unexpected or unwanted substances) and can tell you nothing

about purity or dose.

The use of a test kit is a harm reduction strategy and does not remove the risk of taking drugs completely.

Even 'pure' drugs can be dangerous.
